

# EXTRA- CURRICULAR MUSICAL INSTRUMENT & VOCAL TUITION 2018

## ENROLMENT / RE-ENROLMENT APPLICATION INFORMATION

In 2018, students from **Year 3 upwards may apply** for weekly lessons in the following: flute, saxophone, trumpet, violin, cello, folk/rock guitar electric and bass guitar, piano, keyboard, drums.

A discount of \$100 is offered to first year students in trumpet or saxophone from Year 10 or below.

Instrumental/vocal lessons will be individual or in groups of 2-4, dependent on student level and/or demand. Vocal lessons may be weekly or fortnightly dependent on the demand for lessons.

### Final placements in lessons will be at the discretion of Mrs Grant.

Most lessons take place during school hours on Botany and Golflands campuses with the option of individual piano/keyboard lessons after school at the Botany Campus on Monday, Wednesday or Friday and at the Golflands Campus on Tuesday. In most cases lessons at the Botany Campus will be on a rotating timetable to avoid missing the same classes. Lessons at the Golflands Campus will be on a rotation where practical.

**Successful applicants** will be notified by Mrs Grant and timetables emailed. Lessons are scheduled to start in the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of the first term. Students not placed in lessons will be placed on **waiting lists** and notified via email as soon as possible.

### **ENROLMENT APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

- APPLICATIONS with Direct Debit Form must be received before <u>9 February</u>

- Completed <u>Direct Debit</u> Forms should be placed in the silver box at Botany Campus or handed into the Golflands Campus office
- · Re-enrolments must be received from students who wish to continue lessons at school
- · Students on current waiting lists must also confirm their continued interest in lessons at school

### POLICY FOR TUITION AND FEES- Please read carefully

- 1. Students MUST have access to an instrument for regular practice.
- 2. Individual weekly lessons are a prerequisite for NCEA music students (privately or through Elim Christian College).
- 3. Preference for lessons is given to students taking NCEA music and those who are continuing from 2017.
- 4. Students taking lessons at school are expected to be involved in school musical performing groups as required.
- 5. Individual instrument lessons weekly 20min / 25min / 30min / 40min @ \$530 / \$610 / \$690 / \$850 per year.
- 6. Individual vocal lessons weekly 30min @ \$690 per year, fortnightly 30 min @ \$345.
- 7. Group instrument lessons of 2-4 students weekly 25-30min @ \$530 per year.
- 8. Group vocal lessons weekly 30 min @ \$530 lessons or fortnightly 30 min @ \$265 per year.
- 9. Lesson fees are to be paid by submitting a completed **Direct Debit Form** with the application **OR** by paying **half the yearly fees** for terms 1 & 2 in advance **immediately on confirmation of lessons** with the balance for term 3 & 4 to be paid before term 2 finishes.
- 10. Additional costs may include a teaching book or other resource material, by arrangement with the music tutor.
- 11. Lessons run for 34 weeks. Lessons may be disrupted due to a busy school programme, teacher sickness, public holidays.
- 12. Missed lessons MAY be made up where possible, but this is subject to availability of teachers and rooms. Lessons will only be credited if the student has less than the minimum 30 lessons per year (or 15 fortnightly vocal lessons) and details of missed lessons are emailed to Mrs Grant at the end of the year.
- 13. Students should make every effort where possible to rearrange a lesson in advance by emailing Mrs Grant. Missed lessons due to student sickness or a non-school related reason cannot be reimbursed.
- 13. It is expected that students continue lessons for the full school year or for a minimum of two terms.
- 14. Withdrawal from music tuition in Term 3-4 must be made by Week 5 of Term 2 to Mrs Pam Grant on pam.grant@elim.school.nz
