The **UniBound Academic Enrichment programme**, a summer programme open to all Māori and Pacific students who have applied or are interested in applying to The University of Auckland.

UniBound Summer: January 15 – February 16

This is a FREE on campus programme that has been designed to enhance learning and university preparedness.

UniBound Summer offers students the following learning experiences before they begin their respective degree or foundation programmes in Semester One.

- Academic preparation in numeracy and literacy
- Learning about Pacific and Māori cultures and knowledge
- Off-campus learning activities—such as field trips to the Marine biology lab, sports days, and intercampus visits
- University 101: getting to grips with study at the University—where and how to do things
- Team building activities and peer mentoring
- Working on projects in tech or culture or research
- A two night overnight stay in University accommodation

UniBound Foundation: Semester One and Semester Two

Students who do not achieve University Entrance or do not meet programme entry requirements will possibly be eligible for the UniBound Foundation where they will undertake the Tertiary Foundation Certificate (TFC). This is a two semester foundation programme.

The UniBound team will provide academic and pastoral support during their TFC programme.
