

The Bible

We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, and that none may add to or take away from, except at their peril.

The Trinity

We believe that the Godhead eternally exists in three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit and these three are one God.

The Church

We believe that the church consists of all persons who have been regenerated by the Holy Spirit and made new creatures in Christ Jesus.

The Saviour

We believe that all have sinned and come short of the glory of God, and that through the death and risen power of Christ all who believe and confess Jesus as Lord can be saved from the penalty and power of sin.

The Healer

We believe that our Lord Jesus Christ is the Healer, and that healing is provided for in the atonement.

The Baptiser

We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ is the Baptiser in the Holy Spirit, and that this Baptism with signs following is promised to every believer.

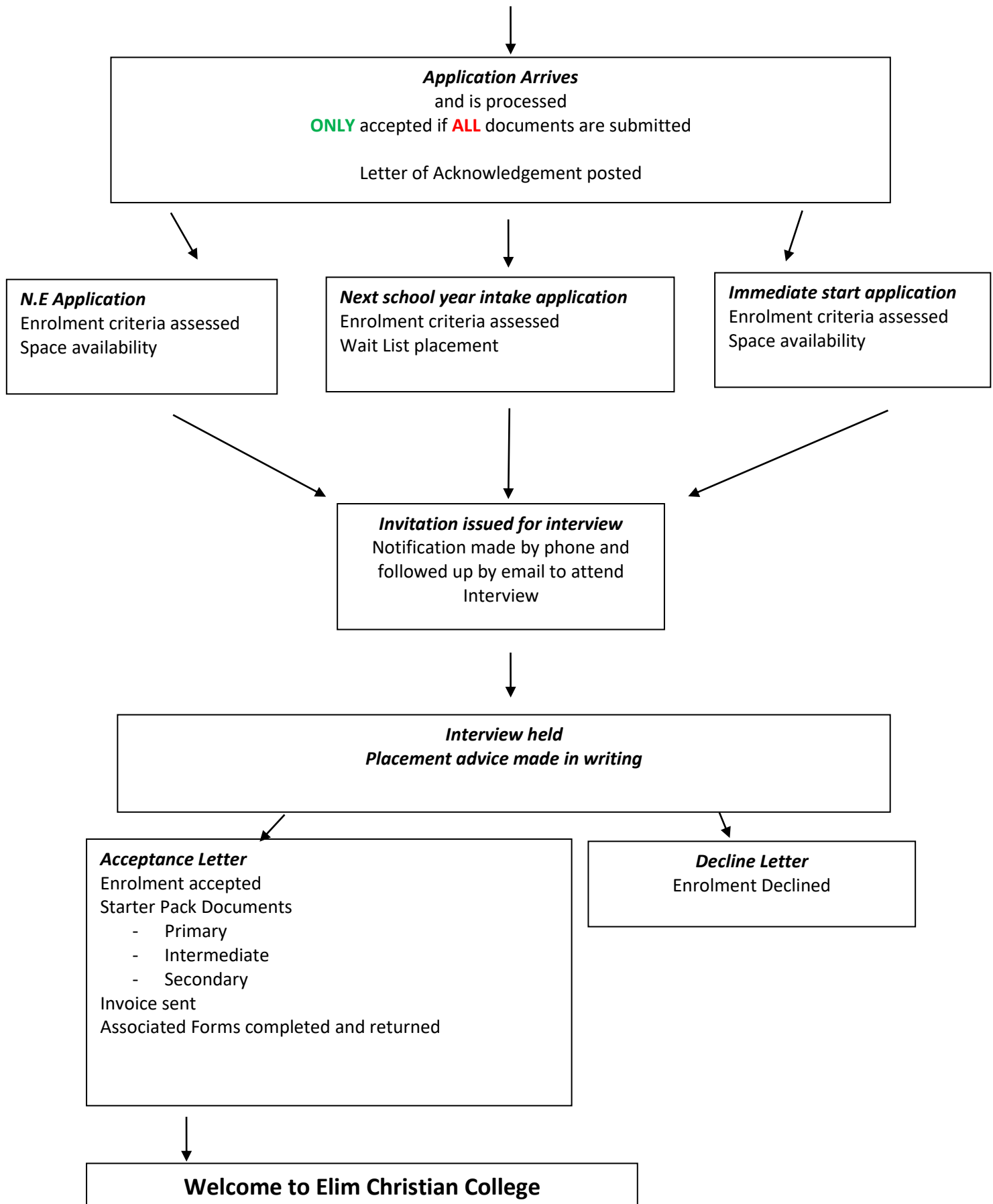

PROPOSED FRANKLIN CAMPUS

Elim Christian Centre Auckland issued a press release on the 15th June 2017 outlining exciting plans on the horizon including information regarding Elim Franklin:

- *The church has purchased 8.99 hectares of land in 16 Yates Road, Pukekohe, to expand and provide facilities for our existing congregation (Elim Franklin) and land that has the capacity to accommodate a large school campus. This property is Future Urban on the edge of Pukekohe township with easy access to Pukekohe train station and town centre.*

Whilst we do not yet have a school on the Pukekohe site, Elim Christian College is looking forward to this being established in the future.
