Introducing the ICAS assessments for 2020

Welcome to the 2020 International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS). For over 30 years ICAS has taken place each year in schools throughout Australia, New Zealand, Singapore, Malaysia, Brunei, the Pacific region and South Africa. Your child is invited to participate in these exams as an optional/extra-curricular activity. See costs below.

ICAS provides an opportunity for all Years 3-13 students to gain a measure of their own achievement in an external testing situation. It provides teachers, parents and students with comprehensive reporting of results in the areas of Digital Technologies, English, Mathematics, Science, Spelling and Writing.

Last year, UNSW changed to on-line ICAS competitions and also included REACH exams designed for benchmarking and measuring student progress. We will no longer offer REACH exams as our own NZ Progress and Achievement Tests (PATs) provide more consistent and reliable information. All Y3-10 students at Elim Christian College undertake these exams in different subjects at each year level.
