Children will bring home a pamphlet on Friday with some information. Please do not enter credit card details onto this form. Come in during the week and you can pay by credit card using the EFTPOS facility in the library.

**Character dress-up day:** Friday the 20th of September for all students and teachers. Students will be able to dress up as any book character that we have in the Elim Christian College library.

**Character parade:** On Friday, after lunch, parents are invited to see a character parade - children will walk around the top field twice in their costumes, accompanied by music.
