

FINAL FUNDRAISING NOTICE —'MINT CONDITION'

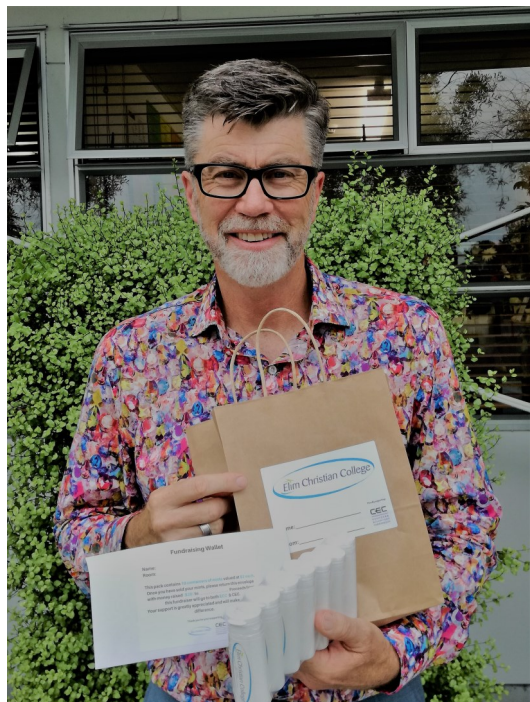
