#### ECCO – Elim Christian College Online

A website has been set up to access online learning for Junior Years students. You will need to copy this link and paste into your browser. Mrs Vermeulen will send through the link on Tuesday afternoon via Seesaw.

We understand that classes are using Seesaw and Google Classrooms. For Years 3-6, links have been provided on ECCO for you to access Google Classrooms. For Y1-2, hard copies

of the workbook were provided before lockdown commenced. However, if you were unable to pick up a hard copy, this has been saved on the ECCO website for you to download. For all classes, ECCO may direct you to work to be done on Seesaw and Google Classrooms as well.

Please note that we will be providing a timetable for you when the online learning programme kicks in on the 15th of April. The timetable aims to create a balanced day for our students. It has been wonderful to see the variety in initiative over the past few days around how the days are being organised. However, we do understand that these are unusual times, and we encourage all our parents to gauge what will work best for their children on any specific day, that you decide how much can be accomplished in a day and the nature of activities that would best suit any given day.
