Our Trash to Fashion Show will be held week 1 of term 3 so book the date in your calendar so you don't miss it.

This term our Year 7 students will participate in Attitude workshops run by the Parenting place. These workshops are complimented by a parent evening Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> June. These evenings are designed for you to attend with your child and to initiate some great discussions between you and your child around the changes they are going through. We strongly encourage you to attend.

During this term our Year 7 students will attend the Science Roadshow. It would be great to have some parents join us to help manage small groups as we explore and experiment.

Our Year 8 students will once again be heading out to Corban Estate to attend an art workshop where they will get to create their own artwork pieces.
