Kia Ora one and all

We write to you in the aftermath of the Prime Minister's announcement yesterday. Being a Y1-13 school on 3 locations our situation could be different other schools.

- 1. School will continue as distance learning for all of this week. There is no change for this week.
- 2. This coming weekend is a long weekend for the country and a longer weekend for families with school age children. Monday is the ANZAC Day holiday (weird in these circumstances I know).
- 3. Tuesday when Alert Level 3 commences it is a staff only day so no lessons will be delivered via distance that day across all year groups.
- 4. For Y11-13 students distance learning continues under Alert Level 3 further notice. Botany Campus remains closed for all onsite learning.

Regarding the opening of our campuses from Wednesday 29 April

- 1. The government and schools strongly encourage all Y1-10 students continue to engage in distance learning from their place of lockdown.
- 2. The key message for you is that if you can, you should keep your child at home. You should only physically send your child to school if you need to.
- 3. If your child has a health condition that means they are at a greater risk of a severe illness you must keep them at home. If your child is sick please also ensure you keep them at home.
- 4. In order to ensure the safety of those children and our staff who do come to school, we will be operating with strict enforcement of health and safety measures.
- 5. We want to assure you that we will continue to support your child's learning at home.
- 6. The Ministry of Education has advised that they are working closely with the Ministry of Health to develop clear guidance that will support us to safely re-open our GC and MAC campuses to students and staff. This will help us work through the public health requirements that we all need to meet. As you will be doing, we want to be sure that what we do will keep our community as safe as possible.
- 7. For now, we will continue to support your child's learning by distance while we progress our planning for what Alert Level 3 will mean for you and for our school. <u>Further information will</u> be sent out on Friday.
- 8. Not all staff are able to return to school, in fact as at the time of writing 38 staff are unable to this may restrict what we can do
- 9. Safety is the number one priority in whatever we do as a school, we do not wish any family's safety or any member of staff's safety to be compromised
- 10. Parents of Year 1-10 students are requested to <u>immediately</u> complete a google survey ONLY IF YOU INTEND TO HAVE YOUR CHILDREN RETURN TO FACE TO FACE SCHOOL Wednesday April, 29: https://forms.gle/vF4pEMXhWNT2Wqy18
