Dear Parents / Caregivers,

This letter is reminder of the deadline for the external folio assessments which are worth 12 credits (Level 1 & 2) and 14 credits (Level 3).

Year 11 (Level 1) folio due: Friday 18 October (Term 4, Week 1) Year 12 (Level 2) folio due: Friday 25 October (Term 4, Week 2) Year 13 (Level 3) folio due: Friday 1 November (Term 4, Week 3)

Students are expected to consistently work on their art in and outside of class time each week in order to complete the assessment successfully and achieve the best results by the due date. There will be NO EXTENSIONS for this assessment.

This year, NCEA Visual Arts students have been given the opportunity to attend Art Workshops at Elim Christian College. The reason for these workshops is to give students the chance to work on their individual folio board requirements for extended lesson time, which is not available to them during the usual school week. It also provides students with valuable 1:1 professional guidance from the art teacher.
