Dear Parent(s)/Caregiver(s),

This letter is a reminder that in Week Four of this term, your child will take part in the NCEA Literacy and Numeracy Co-requisite digital assessments. These assessments are designed to evaluate the foundational literacy and numeracy skills required for success in NCEA and beyond. In order to be awarded an NCEA qualification, students must achieve all three co-requisites: Literacy (Reading), Literacy (Writing), and Numeracy.

The digital assessments will be held at school in the Year 10 Maunga space during Periods 1 and 2. The schedule is as follows:

Literacy (Reading): Tuesday 20 May

Numeracy: Wednesday 21 May

Literacy (Writing): Friday 23 May

Please note that **Thursday 22 May will be a home learning day for all Year 10 students.**

Along with their charged device, your child needs to bring the following items in a clear plastic bag:

- Blue or black pens
- Pencils
- An eraser
- Headphones (optional)
- A calculator (Numeracy assessment only)
