Where: Willow Park Christian Camp (Eastern Beach)

Dates: 17th-19th May 2021

Drop Off and Pick Up:

On Monday 17th May, please drop your child to Willow Park Christian Camp between **8:00am-8:30am**. There will be a designated place for your child to drop their bags and equipment. We ask that parents/caregivers assist with moving bags from the car to the drop off zone, if necessary. However only students and registered parent helpers are allowed access to the dormitories for health and safety reasons.

On Wednesday 19th May, our camp programme will conclude by 3:00pm. Please arrange to pick up your child from Willow Park Christian Camp between **3:00pm-3:30pm**. All students' bags and equipment will be in the drop off zone, ready for collection.

We will not be transporting anyone to or from school.

Equipment:

A Student Equipment List is available via our school website. Please check through the list to ensure your child is prepared for camp. We ask that students do not bring any electronic devices to camp. Our teachers and parent helpers will be taking lots of photos to share when we get back.

Information around Visiting:

For health and safety reasons we are unable to provide parents, caregivers and whānau access to the camp throughout our stay. This is so we can ensure we account for who is on site at all times.
