

Kia Ora Elim community

As Principal, I have consulted with the Board and based on the current information available to us as outlined below, our school, Elim Christian College - all 3 campuses Botany, Golflands and Mt Albert will be closed for Monday 13 February. This decision is made with the safety of all our school community in mind and is not taken lightly.

We have based this decision on the following:

1. The following message for Auckland Schools from the Secretary for Education

"It is the responsibility of Boards to make the decision to close their school if they consider that it is not safe for on-site teaching and learning. Further to the most recent information from Emergency Management advising the upgrading of the warning to a Red warning for Auckland, I recommend that the Boards of Auckland schools make a decision to close their schools for on-site instruction from Monday 13 February. Schools should reopen as soon as possible, subject to mitigating and managing risks. Iona Holsted"

- 2. The strength of the expected cyclone
- 3. Advice from Emergency Management Auckland
- 4. Message from the Auckland City Council to avoid all unnecessary travel
- 5. Minimizing the safety variables that staying open for on-site attendance would bring namely road closures, power outages, having to retain students at school with limited supplies of food, water complicated by any power outages, the challenge of maintaining safety on our sites in view of high winds etc....
- 6. The existing fragility of Auckland's infrastructure and already waterlogged grounds

As this is a short closure and so near to the start of term, there will be no provision for online learning tomorrow.

A decision will be made shortly after 1.00pm tomorrow regarding arrangements for Tuesday 14th February and even Wednesday 15 February. This decision will come only from me as Principal on behalf of the Board.

Families should continue to monitor and follow all advice from Auckland Emergency Management.

Following this update, Deputy Principals may communicate with your campus as and when they need to.
