Entry and Exit to the school site

- All Junior Years students enter through the main gate at the front of the school.
- Year 7 and 8 students enter and exit through the Simon Owen small gate.
- Year 9 and 10 students enter and exit at the Montecito gate.
- Students with siblings can either enter through their areas or they can accompany their siblings.
- Bus students enter through the side gate near the hall.
- If students walk to school, ride a bicycle, or are on a scooter, then they must enter through the small gate next to the main staff car park gate. Train them to look for cars and always use a helmet!

Punctuality and phones

- All students must be at school by 8.40 am. We value punctuality!
- For students in Years 7-10 please see to it that your child arrives at school with a fully charged device - ready for learning each day.
- We don't use mobile phones as learning devices. Mobile phones MAY NOT BE used during the school day - this will be strictly enforced!

All belongings must always be named.

Students must wear a school hat in Terms 1 and 4. We are sun smart at all times! This includes the top field if you are playing or sitting.
