

My Devotional Story

As I reflect on the times we live in and the recent happenings of this

past week or two, I want to encourage you with a story I have told a

few times and it has brought encouragement to the hearers.

Two weeks before lockdown 4 of my students were doing a weekly Student

led Devotional on a topic of their choice for the rest of the class in

our daily 40 minute Christian Living/Devotional time.

The first student got up and shared her belief and worth found in God

and gave her scripture as Isaiah 41:10: So do not fear, for I am with

you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and

help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

The second student spoke, then the third student shared on Peace, with

the key scripture Isaiah 41:10. We commented on how amazing it was

that it was the same verse. The last student got up and shared on

having God there in times of trouble and hardship and anchored his talk with Isaiah 41:10. We were now really listening to what God had to say to us.

I asked the class to get out their Devotional books and write this

verse out however they felt God had spoken to them that day. One of the students asked to go to his bag to get his Bible.

the students asked to go to his bag to get his Bible. On his return I

watched him drop the Bible open on his desk and it fell open to Isaiah

41 and verse 10 was highlighted in yellow. He couldn't believe his

eyes and we all celebrated the fact we believed God really wanted us

to be listening and paying attention.

I decided the next week we would learn it instead of the planned

weekly memory verse, which we did. Two days later we were in Lockdown.

Now, two and a half weeks into lockdown, we are revisiting this verse

regularly and reminding ourselves that God is in control and he has us

in his righteous right hand. There is nothing to fear or be


discouraged about because God is on the throne and we can trust that He has got this.
