HOMEWORK: Students will receive a homework sheet every week. Weekly homework will include learning a memory verse, word rings or spelling, and reading. On Fridays, we will test memory verse, word rings or spelling. Please sign your child's homework book every day. See your child's homework book for more information. Please note that home reading books must be carried in a book bag and must be returned to school before your child is given a new one.

Mathletics / Reading Eggs: Payment of this subscription is optional this year. You are still able to sign your child up for these through the family subscription on their website, and you can roll over your child's school account to a private one. Maths Buddy and Maths Whizz are also effective programmes depending on the purpose you want to subscribe to an external programme. We highly recommend these programmes to enhance your child's understanding of the subjects and to provide practice opportunities at home. This is especially important if your child needs support in achieving the expected levels in Reading, Writing and Mathematics.

Before and after-school care
