HOMEWORK: Students will receive a homework sheet every week. Homework will include a Maths Task, spelling and reading. The homework sheet will also include some optional activities. Homework is due on Fridays when we will test memory verse and spelling weekly. Please see your child’s homework book for more information.

iPADS: Please ensure your child’s iPad is charged every day before school. iPads will be stored safely in the classroom.

Mathletics / Reading Eggs: Payment of this subscription is optional this year. You are still able to sign your child up for these through the family subscription on their website, and you can roll over your child’s school account to a private one. Maths Buddy and Maths Whizz are also effective programmes depending on the purpose you want to subscribe to an external programme. We highly recommend these programmes to enhance your child's understanding of the subjects and to provide practice opportunities at home. *This is especially important if your child needs support in achieving the expected levels in Reading, Writing and Mathematics.*

Before and after-school care
