Parents and students **MUST** read this information **BEFORE** filling out and signing the Online Music Tuition Enrolment Form

Tuition will commence in Week 4, Term 1 (from 23 February)

PAYMENT MUST BE COMPLETED BY MONDAY 16TH FEBRUARY

INSTRUMENT HIRE - EXCLUSIVE HIRE SCHEME

- Bear in mind that Botany do not just have stock in store and rental booking has to be completed before goods are sent to the location for pickup.
- Collection is either from **Botany, Sylvia Park or Epsom** stores.

INDIVIDUAL LESSONS ONLY: \$900 - 30 LESSONS

- THESE FEES MUST BE PAID BY THE DUE DATES.
- **Fees can be paid in full or in two installments - First installment \$510 (17 lessons) due 16th February 2026, Second installment \$390 (13 lessons) due 6th July 2026.**
- Failure to pay fees by the agreed time will result in withdrawal from tuition.
- Lessons are 30 minutes long.
- Students must be very sure to tell their tutor well in advance (at least 24 hours' notice) if they will be absent from a lesson, as the tutor has set aside that time slot specifically. Tutors will do their best to organise catch up lessons where possible (one catch up lesson per term only).
- There is **no refund** if a student misses a lesson or chooses to withdraw.
- It is highly recommended that students taking NCEA Music enrol for tuition. Many performances will need to be prepared throughout the year, and the students need a lesson which is individually tailored to suit their needs. Students taking Year 9 and 10 Music should also consider Individual Tuition on their instrument/voice.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS: WE ASK PARENTS AND STUDENTS TO READ AND ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING

- Students from Year 3 to Year 13 can apply for Individual lessons.
- By enrolling for tuition students are committing to attend **all 30 lessons** over the course of the year.
- **Lessons are a PREREQUISITE for NCEA Music students** (privately or through Elim Christian College).
- Preference for lessons will be given to students taking NCEA music and those who are continuing from 2025.
- 2025 Students who wish to continue lessons at school in 2026 **MUST also RE-ENROL.**
- Lessons predominantly take place during school hours. In most cases, lessons at Botany Campus (BC) will be on a rotating timetable to avoid missing the same classes. Lessons at Golflands (GC) and Botany (BC) will be on a rotation where possible.
- **Students must give their tutor at least 24hrs notice if they will be absent from a lesson** (this includes due to school events eg, sports days.)
- In the event that a tutor is away, lessons will be made up at a later date (extra day, school holidays or in the Term 4), or a relief tutor will be scheduled to take classes. The tutor is not expected to reshuffle their timetable to accommodate students who cannot attend at their scheduled lesson time. *It is perfectly reasonable for a tutor to count a lesson as taken if a student fails to turn up without giving sufficient prior warning.*
- Students are expected to practice the work set by their tutor each week.
- Additional costs may include a teaching book or other resource material, by arrangement with the music tutor.

- Students are expected to take responsibility for coming OUT of their timetabled class to attend music tuition. We encourage students to set alarms.
- If you are taking Music as a classroom subject, you will need to discuss performance assessments and requirements with your tutor clearly and in advance so your tutor can help you prepare for these.
- All students are required to have their OWN instrument (hired or purchased) to use for tuition at school. Students are not permitted to borrow instruments from the Music Department - an exception may be made in emergency situations.
- PIANO and DRUM students DO NOT NEED to bring their own instruments to school. Drummers must bring their own sticks and electric guitarists and bassists must bring their own leads to lessons.
- Lessons at all campuses will be dependent on demand at each campus.
- Successful applicants will be notified by the Itinerant Music Coordinator and timetables emailed out. Lessons are scheduled to start in Week 4, Term 1 (Monday Feb 23). Unsuccessful applicants will be placed on waiting lists and notified via email as soon as possible. Final placements in lessons will be at the discretion of the Itinerant Music Coordinator. Music Tutors are not to be contacted directly for enrolment.
- **Students wishing to withdraw from lessons will forfeit their fees.** No refunds will be issued.
- **Students enrolled in itinerant lessons, such as woodwind, brass, strings or vocal are expected to participate in extracurricular music activities at school to further enhance and broaden their musical experience.**

PAYMENT

Payment must be made in full or in two installments - First installment \$510 (17 lessons) due 16th February 2026, Second installment \$390 (13 lessons) due 6th July 2026.

The payment must be received by Monday 16 February for lessons to commence.
FAILURE TO PAY FEES BY THE AGREED TIME WILL RESULT IN WITHDRAWAL FROM TUITION

\$900 (30 X INDIVIDUAL LESSONS)

Participation in Music Tuition will cost \$900 and will be invoiced via KAMAR to enable you to pay this via the parent portal. If you do not know how to access the portal please email: accounts@elim.school.nz

MUSIC TUITION - PARENT/GUARDIAN AGREEMENT

- We (all parents/guardians) have read, understood, and agree to the **Terms and Conditions** of taking Music Tuition at Elim Christian College.
- We understand that the music lessons are **very likely to be timetabled during school**

hours, and that this student will have to come out of his/her timetabled subject to attend music lessons.

- As parents we understand that it is our responsibility to **make payment of fees by the due dates.**
- By enrolling our student, we are agreeing to **commit to four terms.**
- We understand that students must give their tutor **at least 24hrs notice if they will be absent from a lesson** (this includes due to school events eg, sports days.)
- We understand there is **no refund if a student misses a lesson or chooses to withdraw.**
- We understand that only one missed lesson per term can be made up.
