Year 3-8 SPEECH COMPETITION

Dear Parents,

As part of our Year 3-8 Literacy program this term, your child will be preparing and presenting a speech to their class. This will take place during Week 5, 23rd - 27th August.

From this, the following finalists will be selected for the School Speech Competition.

- 6 students from Junior Years 3 and 4 (from Room 5 and 6)
- 6 students from Junior Years 5 and 6 (from Room 9 and 10)
- 6 students from Intermediate Years 7 and 8 (from Room 11, 12 and 16)

The School Speech Competition will be held in the hall on Friday, 3rd September. Families are welcome.

- 9:15am for Junior Years 3 and 4
- 10:00 for Junior Years 5 and 6
- 11:15 for Intermediate Years 7 and 8

Speech Preparation

Every student will **prepare a speech in class time** that may then be practised at home. Speech lengths are:

- Junior Years 3 and 4, (2 minutes)
- Junior Years 5 and 6, (2.5 minutes)
- Intermediate Years 7 and 8, (3 minutes.)

The student's speech must be within 15 seconds of the time stated.

The topics are listed below. Please ensure they choose from the appropriate level. It is important that your child independently selects their topic. Speeches must be written at school. Please help your child find suitable resources to research their topic. They will need to bring these to school and use them to prepare their speech.

In order for your child to be considered for the Year 5-6 Eden/Albert Cluster Zone Final Speech Competition their speech must be on the topic of Diversity.
