Dear Parents, Caregivers and Students,

The <u>Worship Teams at Botany and Mt. Albert Campus</u> are now using In-Ear Monitors (IEMs) as the main way of monitoring our sound onstage. At Botany, this is something we have had to do since moving back into the Elim Church Auditorium. At Mt. Albert, we are upgrading the Hall sound system to allow for the use of IEMs.

IEMs are widely used by churches and productions as a way to minimise stage volume and create a better sounding mix for the congregation.

If your child already has some IEMs, then you do not need to get another set. We are recommending that the following groups of students have IEMs for 2023:

- ALL Band members at both campuses guitar, bass, drums, keys
- ALL Vocals at Botany
- ONLY Worship Leaders at Mt. Albert until we can put all the vocals on IEMs

We have investigated some very reasonable products and prices that students can purchase through the school. If you are interested, **please indicate on this online form by Friday 24 March**.
