In week four of term two, your child will have the opportunity to sit the NCEA literacy and numeracy co-requisite digital assessments.

All assessments will be conducted at school during Periods 1 & 2.

The assessment timetable is as follows:

- Literacy (Reading) Tuesday 21st May
- Numeracy Thursday 23rd May
- Literacy (Writing) Friday 24th May

Please note that Wednesday 22nd May is a home-learning day for all Year 10 students.

We have been preparing your child to sit these assessments at school. You can further support your child by encouraging them to complete practice literacy and numeracy tasks on <u>Pathways Awarua</u> or by completing previous digital assessments, accessible through their NZQA learner login. We also recommend the purchase of the English Handbook and Study Guide to support your child's grasp of grammar and punctuation. For those students who did not purchase the book last year or who have not purchased it this year, a charge of \$40 has been loaded onto your parent account.
