I am writing to outline the arrangements for the NCEA co-requisite assessments next week.

Your child will be sitting the following digital assessments:

Literacy (Reading) **Tuesday 21st May**

Numeracy **Thursday 23rd May**

Literacy (Writing) **Friday 24th May**

All assessments will take place at **Golflands Campus** during **periods 3 and 4** (please note the change in assessment time). Students will remain at school for the duration of the school day and will attend timetabled classes in periods 1, 2, 5 and 6.

As previously communicated, **Wednesday 22nd May** is a **home-learning day** for all Year 10 students. No Year 10 students, including international students, should attend school on Wednesday 22nd May.

We have been preparing your child to sit these assessments at school.
