08 TIRITIRI ISLAND TRIP

This Year 08 trip will be completed in two groups, with 48 students attending on each day.

Dates: Trip A: Wednesday 10 September 2025. Trip B: Friday 12 September 2025.

Location: Tiritiri Island, Hauraki Gulf. Transport via Bus from Golflands Campus to Britomart CBD. Further transport via Ferry from CBD to Tiritiri Island. Returning the same way.

7.20am bus departure. Please note we have a 9am Ferry departure from the city. We need to leave no later than 7.20am from Golflands Campus. Students are to be at school no later than 7.00am for roll call.

Students will need to bring a decent amount of water as they will be walking around the island (atleast 1L but preferably more). Students will need a **packed lunch** with enough food to last them through to 5.00pm.
