Working in partnership with Te Whatu Ora, our aim is to improve the number of high school students accessing quality dental care.

This is your opportunity to enrol your adolescent with us for their **free dental care**. We will see students from **years 9 to 13 (under 18 years old)** for their free dental check-up and treatment.

#### What do we offer

Your child’s first appointment with us will consist of:

- Full examination of teeth and overall oral health
- X-rays
- Preventive treatments if needed, including:
  - Simple clean
  - Fissure sealants

- Application of topical fluoride
- Simple fillings if needed

We will then continue see your child yearly for their dental consultation until their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday, unless you inform us otherwise.
