Our Year 7 & 8 Camp is in Week 7 from Tuesday 14 - Friday 17 March. Details about this camp will also be emailed today. Please complete all forms and make the payment for camp promptly so your child is able to attend. There will also be a year 7 and 8 Sports Camp in Matamata in Term Three which will involve some students.

HOMEWORK: Students will receive a homework sheet every week. Homework is due on Fridays. We will check on memory verse and spelling weekly. Homework will include work that reinforces what is happening in the classroom, spelling, memory verse and reading. Maths homework will be via the Education Perfect software.

WASTE MANAGEMENT AND MINIMISATION: All students are required to take their morning-tea and lunch wrappers, uneaten food, etc. home with them. They cannot dispose of it at school. The recycling bins at Mt Albert Campus have little provision for landfill items and food scraps. We would still like to strongly encourage all our parents to pack lunches in reusable containers and to buy in bulk.
